Stephen Gaudet

Im 68 years old with severe asthma and complex airway disease since early childhood. Ive been intubated 55 times (Yes, you read that correctly). Last intubation was April of 2022.

I also have posterior glottic stenosis, my last dialtion was July 2021

I do not have classic COPD and I am not a CO2 retainer. I typically dont desaturate during a flare unless Im super tight.

My baseline lung function is only 25% of normal (FEV1 is less than 0.7 liters), so I have very little reserve when my asthma get bad.

I have major sedation issues, which are well documented. If I need to be intubated please follow the instructions in my chart.

I have a venous access port in my left chest because of poor peripheral access. Im also "ulnar dependent, as I have chronic radial artery occlusion from prior arterial cannulations and ABGs .

Things that help:

Cont albuterol 10mg-20/hr, Bipap, Mag sulfate, IV fentanyl 50-75 mcg PRN air hunger. (Dont worry, you wont knock out my respiratory drive).
